



VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS & CHARGES 2023

The term “Voluntary Contributions” refers to the monies requested from parents towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by K-6 students in their educational program.

The term “Charges” refer to the provision of extra cost optional activities which contributions do not cover. Charges have been approved by the School Board. The following are optional, if no payment is received an appropriate educational activity will be provided. The estimated costs are at an upper limit and will not exceed this amount. These costs will be collected if and when the event occurs. As parents and guardians are given clear and comprehensive details of excursions/incursions and their consent for participation is obtained before the event, the school will not refund charges if the child does not attend. Excursions and incursions have fixed costs which are divided between the number of students attending the excursion.
